SPECIFICATION FOR TUB-TO-SHOWER ALTERATION REQUIRE TO MEET RESIDENT'S SPECIAL PHYSICAL NEEDS

IMPORTANT NOTE: This modification will require a MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP PERMIT and subsequent Inspection. All work to be performed and finished in conformance with New Jersey Uniform Construction Code.

A LEISURE VILLAGE WEST ASSOCIATION PERMIT is required for this installation by a qualified contractor. The contractor must be registered with the Association as properly insured for liability and property damage before a permit is approved or work can be started. The LVW Association reserves the right to inspect the completed installation.



SPECIFICATION

Refer to attached Page 2 drawing

- 1. Remove the tub and tile surrounding the alteration and dispose of all removed parts and materials.
- 2. Provide a 2" floor drain and connect to existing drain line.
- 3. All disturbed earth and backfill must be termite-proofed.
- 4. Provide cement floor sloped to drain. Install 32" x 60" vinyl shower pan over vinyl sheeting, latter to extend over a 4" high threshold.
- 5. All corners in shower to be fiberglass protected with "Wonderboard" backing on 3 walls up 3 feet.
- 6. Install 5" x 6" tile up 6'-6" above floor on walls and 4' x 4' tile on threshold.
- 7. Install Moen or equivalent single shower faucet.
- 8. Install 2 handicap grab bars in location shown, or as directed by owner but located so that bar supports are fastened solidly into wall studs.
- 9. Install sliding door frame through tiled surfaces; mount two doors.
- 10. Patch and paint or redecorate all untiled new or altered wall surfaces.

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
