

CONSTITUTION
OF
LEISURE VILLAGE WEST BILLIARD CLUB

ARTICLE I

Name and Object

- Section 1. NAME: This organization shall be known as Leisure Village West Billiard Club.
- Section 2. OBJECT: To promote good fellowship, social affairs and tournaments. Also to benefit the Billiard Room's activities and needs.

ARTICLE II

Membership

- Section 1. ELIGIBILITY: Any resident of LVW over 18 years of age. Applications shall be submitted to the Secretary, who will add the names to the membership roster.

ARTICLE III

Elections, Terms and Officers

- Section 1. OFFICERS: The officers of the Club shall be a President, Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer.
- Section 2. TERMS OF OFFICE: All officers shall hold a term of office for one year with nominations and elections at the December meeting.

ARTICLE IV

Government

- Section 1. DUTIES OF OFFICERS: The President shall preside at all meetings and appoint all committees.
The Vice President shall take over the duties of the President should he be absent. He shall assume any other duties assigned him by the President and the Club.
The Secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings and shall have charge of all papers pertaining to the office.
The Treasurer shall be custodian of the funds of the Club. He shall collect and deposit all monies of the Club. All checks drawn shall have the Treasurer and one other officer sign the checks.

ARTICLE V

Voting

Section 1. All members may vote upon any issue presented at a regular or special meeting. A simple majority of those voting shall carry any issue except financial matters, which will require two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast. Only members in good standing shall be allowed to vote.

ARTICLE VI

Finance

Section 1. There shall be no membership initiation fees. Annual dues of \$3.00 per member shall be charged, payable January 1 of each year.

ARTICLE VII

Meetings

Section 1. MEETINGS: The Club shall meet the last Thursday of each month except the months of June, July and August. The President shall call all special meetings when necessary.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendments

Section 1. Any changes or additions to these by-laws may be accomplished by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership present.

Section 2. Any changes in the by-laws must be read to the members at one meeting and voted on at the next regular meeting.
