#### **DIVISION REPORTS**

#### ARCHITECTURAL DIVISION

Tom Hardman – Chairperson stated that the Division met at the Association office on November 4, 2016. He reported that there were 6 violations and 5 were completed. He also reported that for the month of October there were 78 permits issued and 67 were completed. The Board of Trustees did not approve to move forward with the proposal for Specification 1\_11 – Installation of Awnings on Roofs; however they did approve to allow stripes for Patio Awnings. The Division will revise Specification 1\_13 – Patio Gates and review at their next meeting. The Division discussed having a letter sent to all contractors doing work in the Village to remind them a permit is required to do work. The Division also reviewed the drafted Architectural Charter and all members were in favor of the proposed changes. This will be sent to the Board for their approval. The next Division meeting will be held on Friday, December 2, 2016 at 9:00a.m. in the Association office.

## **RESIDENT SERVICES**

Sara Zitelli reported that for the month of October VISTON had 25 days of Volunteers, 26 Drivers, 26 Medical Calls, 39 Residents served for a total of 146 Volunteer Hours. The Welcome Committee had 14 New Owners, 3 Renters and 1 Re-Renter for the month of October. The KLVW-TV Studio program for November 21<sup>st</sup> is "Know Your Neighbor" with Sandy Duma, November 28<sup>th</sup> is Thanksgiving Weekend, December 12<sup>th</sup> is "Meet Your Neighbor" with Kevin Murphy and December 19<sup>th</sup> is TBA. There will be a movie on Saturday, November 19<sup>th</sup> at 7PM in Willow Hall – "Miracle from Heaven". She reported that for the month of October there were 517 Residents riding the bus. She also stated that there will not be any Volunteers at the Newspaper Recycling Container until further notice. However, residents can continue to drop off newspaper, books, magazines and junk mail at the container. She also mentioned the passing of Harry Weiner. For the month of October, the Print Shop had 13 jobs for Clubs. She reminded Residents that due to Thanksgiving Blood Pressure and Glucose Testing will be held at Willow Hall on Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>. This will be the last testing until March.

## **FINANCE DIVISION**

Marge King reported for Mary Lou Doner that the Division met briefly on October 25<sup>th</sup> at the Association office.
